This is a list of World War II fighters from Germany. A flying ace or fighter ace is a military aviator credited with shooting down five or more enemy aircraft during dogfights. [1] It is quite certain that 2,500 German fighter pilots achieved bait status, having achieved at least 5 air victories. [2] This Article lists 890 (updated as of October 2017) of these aces. German day and night fighter pilots claimed about 70,000 air victories during World War II, more than 25,000 British or American and more than 45,000 Russian-flown aircraft. 103 German fighter pilots shot down 100 or more enemy aircraft, for a total of about 15,400 victories. About 360 German fighter pilots shot down from 40 to 99 enemy for a total of about 21,000 victories. Approximately 500 German combat leads shot down from 20 to 39 enemy aircraft for a total of approximately 15,000 victories. These achievements were honoured with 453 German day fighter sheds and Zerstörer (destroyer) fighter sheds and 85 German night fighter night fighter (including 14 crew members), for a total of 538 German fighter pilots, who received the Knight's Cross of the Iron Cross. [3] German losses, on the other hand, were likewise very high. About 12,000 German day fighters were killed or are still missing in action, with a further 6,000 injured. The Zerstörer (destroyer) pilots suffered about 2,800 casualties, either killed or missing in action, plus another 900 injured in action. German night fighter losses were also high, in the extent of 3,800 pilots or crew members killed or missing and 1,400 wounded. Hans-Ulrich Rudel was the most decorated flying ace in the Luftwaffe, mainly as a ground-attack bomber pilot with more than 800 vehicles destroyed in addition to its victories over opposing aircraft. [4] Background There are a number of reasons why Germany's highest-scoring pilots shot down far more planes than the most successful Allied pilots. During the first years of the war, German day fighters tended to enjoy favorable tactical conditions; for example, during the Battle of Britain British pilots generally tried to attack the German bombers instead of the fighters who protect them. German combat tactics during this period also tend to be superior to those of the Allies, with formation leaders in particular often with a higher chance of success. [5] Formal and informal Luftwaffe practices also contributed to the high numbers of victories achieved by some pilots. Normal practice in combat units was for the highest-scoring pilot to conduct formations, regardless of their rank, which placed them in the best position to shoot down allied aircraft. The German pilots also typically performed far more combat flying than their Allied equivalents: while the Western Allied air force often rested their fighter pilots or turned them out of combat zones after a certain number of missions or flight hours, German pilots had to fly until they fell victim. [6] Accuracy of claims Main article: Confirmation and overclaiming of air victories During the 1990s, the German archives made available to the public, including microfilm rolls of war records not seen since January 1945. [7] They show that although Luftwaffe generally did not accept a murder without a witness (in which case it was considered only likely and did not count in the victory scoring process), some pilots usually submitted unscum with claims and these sometimes made it through the verification process, particularly if they were made by pilots with established records. [7] Unlike all the other air forces that fought during World War II, Luftwaffe did not accept shared demands, but sometimes it did. Each claim had refer to a particular aircraft, but some victories were awarded to other pilots who had claimed the destruction of the same aircraft. [7] From mid-1943 to 1944, the OKW communiques often overstated Allied bomber losses by a factor of up to these demands existed only in communiques and were not used in victory scoring. Defenders of the German fighter pilots claim that overclaims were eliminated during the confirmation process, but the microfilms show that this was not always the case. [7] The rigorous reviews and comparisons of United archives and German archives show that 90 percent of the submitted claims were confirmed, or found in order for confirmation, until the time the system broke down altogether in 1945.
